## Description




Figure 2. Package Outline




Figure 3. LED Forward Voltage vs. Forward Current




Figure 4. Output Curent vs. Input Current




Figure 5. Output Current vs. Ambient Temperature




Figure 6. Output Current vs. Collector-Emitter Voltage





Figure 7. Dark Current vs. Ambient Temperature




Figure 8. Switching Time Test Circuit and Waveforms




Figure 9. Reflow Profile






Figure 10. Top Mark






