


Fig. 1. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature




Fig. 2. Normalized continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature

$$I_{der} = \frac{I_D}{I_{D(25^{\circ}C)}} \times 100\%$$




Fig. 3. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage




Fig. 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration




Fig. 5. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values






Fig. 7. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

$$T_j=25\,^{\circ}C; V_{DS}=5V$$




Fig. 6. Drain-source on-state risistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$$T_j=25^{\circ}C; I_D=10A$$




Fig. 8. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$$V_{DS} = 25V$$




Fig. 9. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; I_D = 10A$$




Fig. 11. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values

$$T_i = 25^{\circ}C$$




Fig. 10. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

$$I_D = 1 mA; V_{DS} = V_{GS}$$




Fig. 12. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

$$a = \frac{R_{DSon}}{R_{DSon(25^{\circ}C)}}$$




Fig. 13. Input, output and reverse capicitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

$$V_{GS} = 0V; f = 1MHz$$





Fig. 14. Reverse diode current as a function of reverse dioode voltage; typical values
