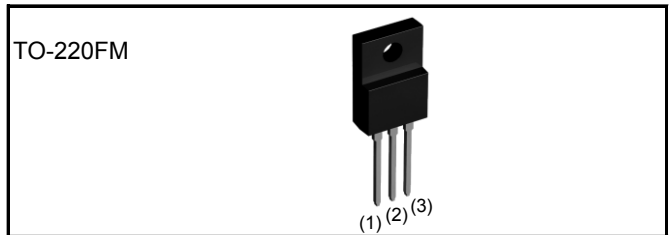

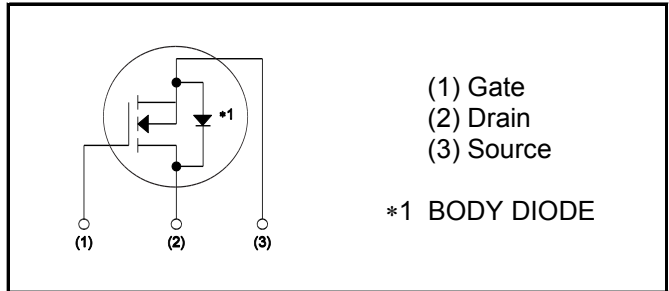

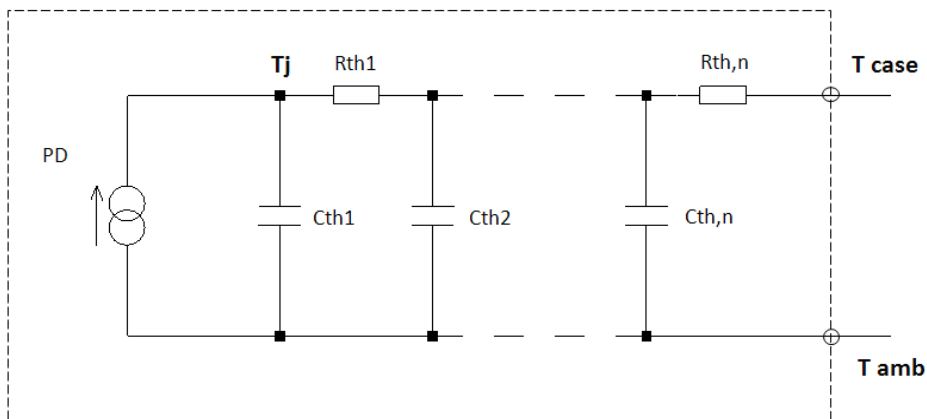

Fig.1 Power Dissipation Derating Curve

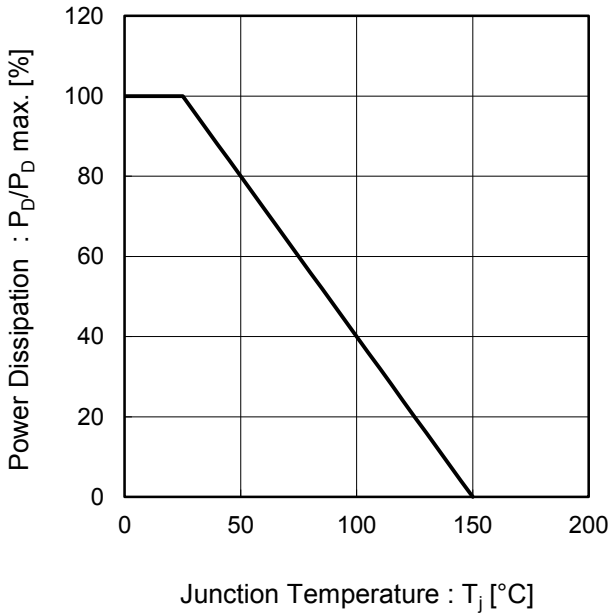


Fig.2 Maximum Safe Operating Area

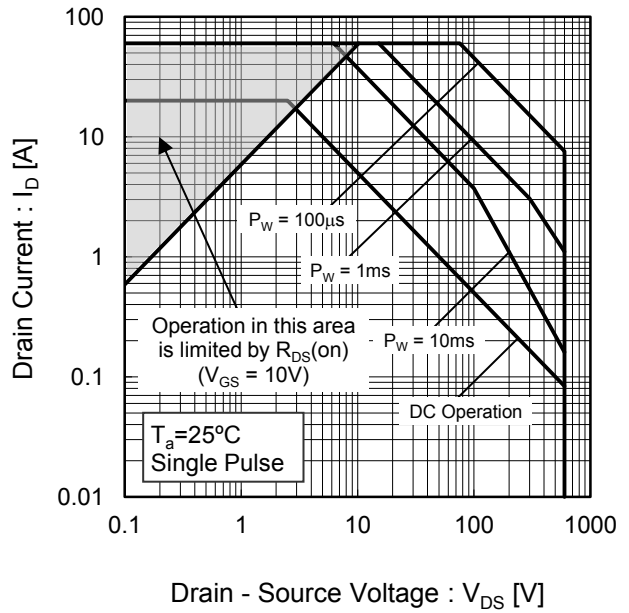


Fig.3 Normalized Transient Thermal Resistance vs. Pulse Width

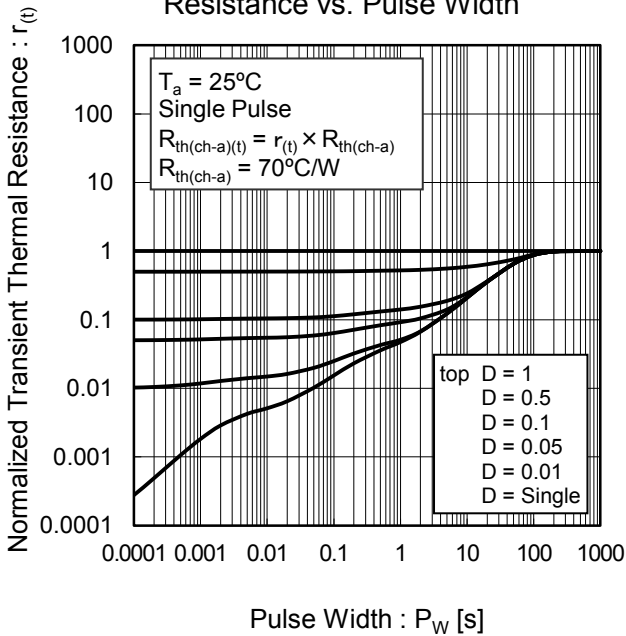
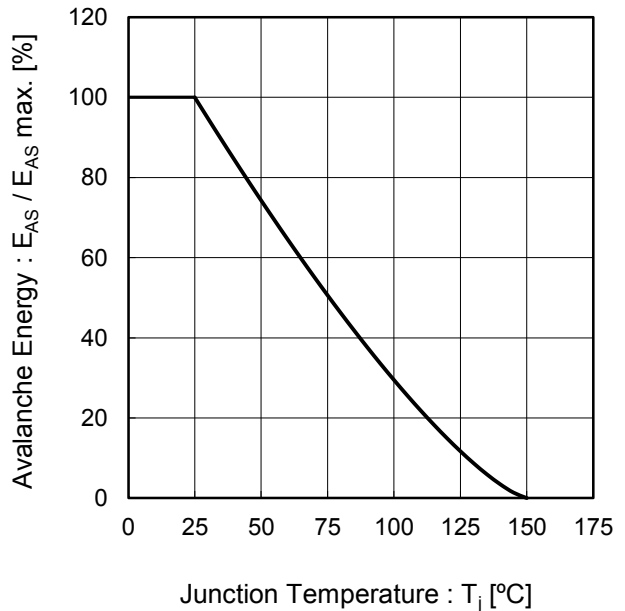


Fig.4 Avalanche Energy Derating Curve vs Junction Temperature

Fig.5 Typical Output Characteristics(I)

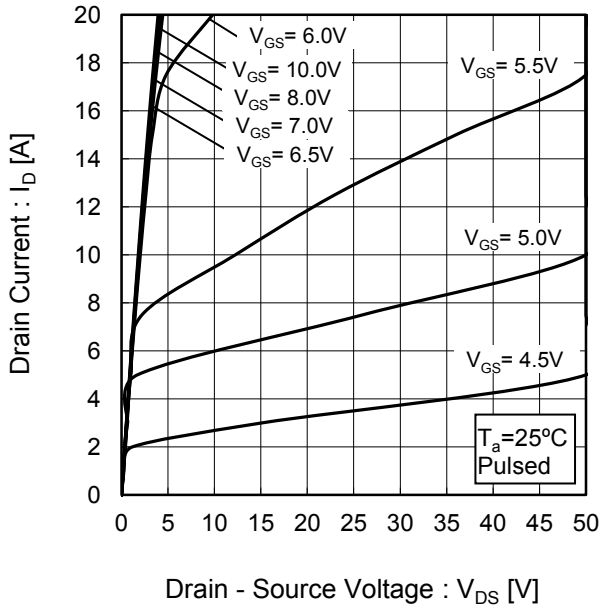


Fig.6 Typical Output Characteristics(II)

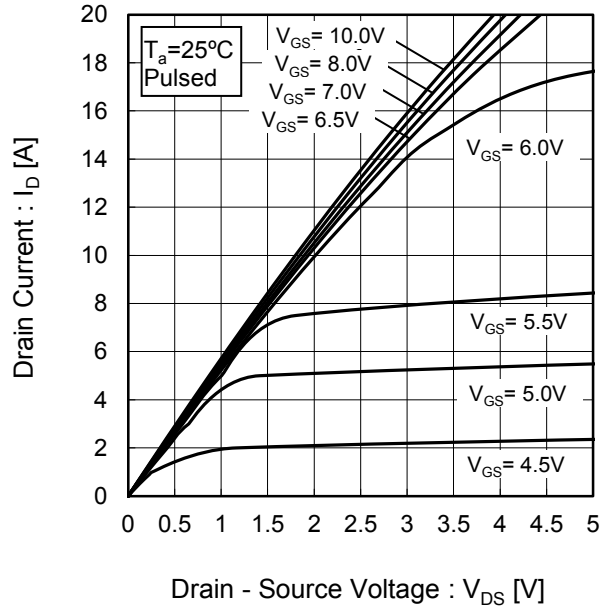


Fig.7 $T_j = 150^\circ\text{C}$ Typical Output Characteristics(I)

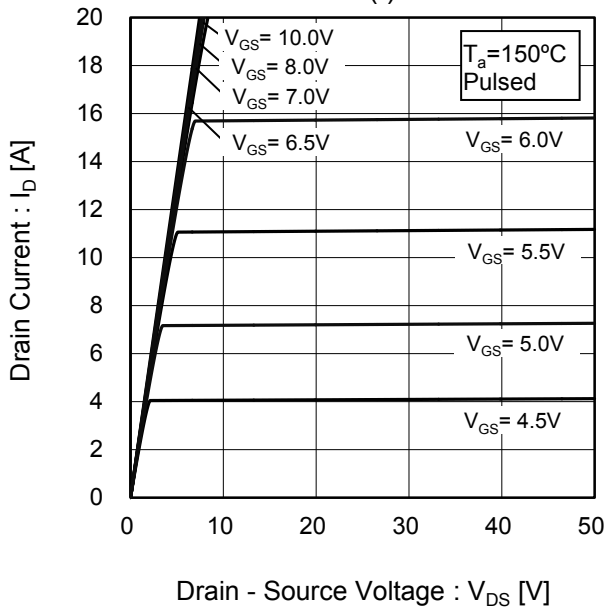
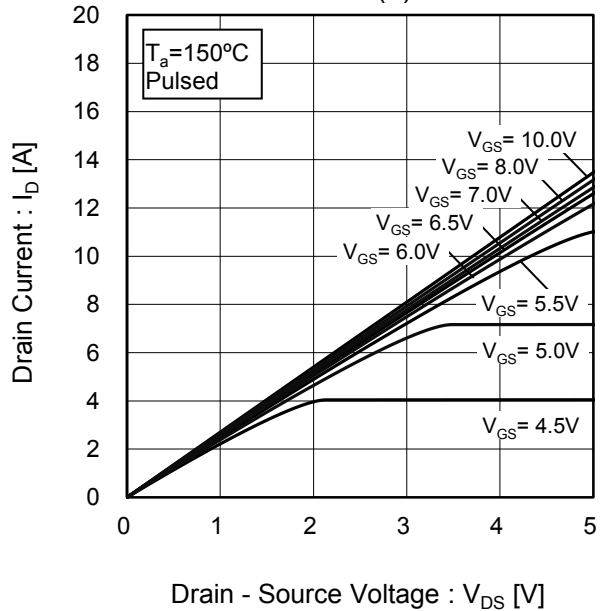


Fig.8 $T_j = 150^\circ\text{C}$ Typical Output Characteristics(II)

Fig.9 Breakdown Voltage vs. Junction Temperature

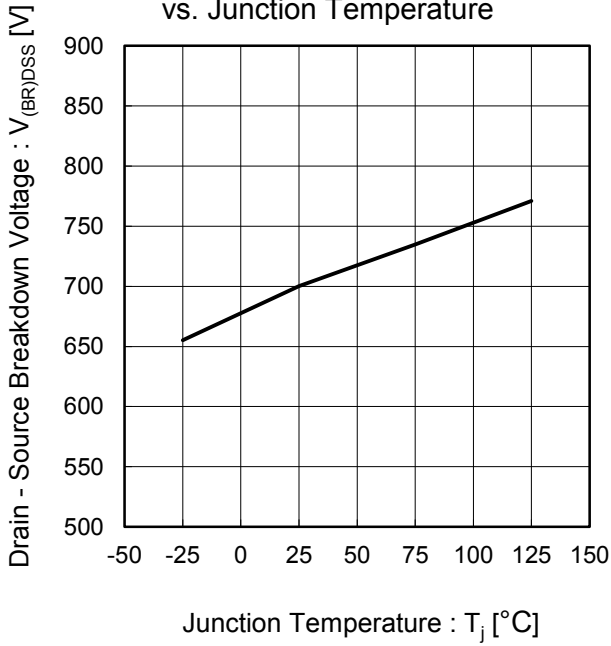


Fig.10 Typical Transfer Characteristics

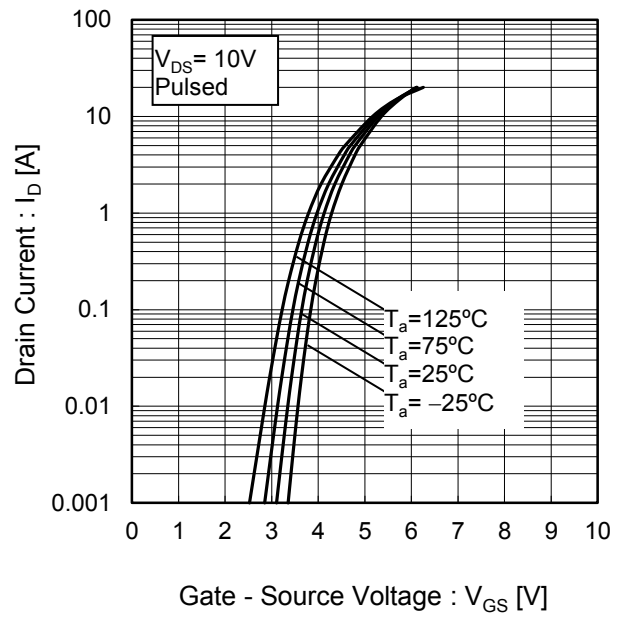


Fig.11 Gate Threshold Voltage vs. Junction Temperature

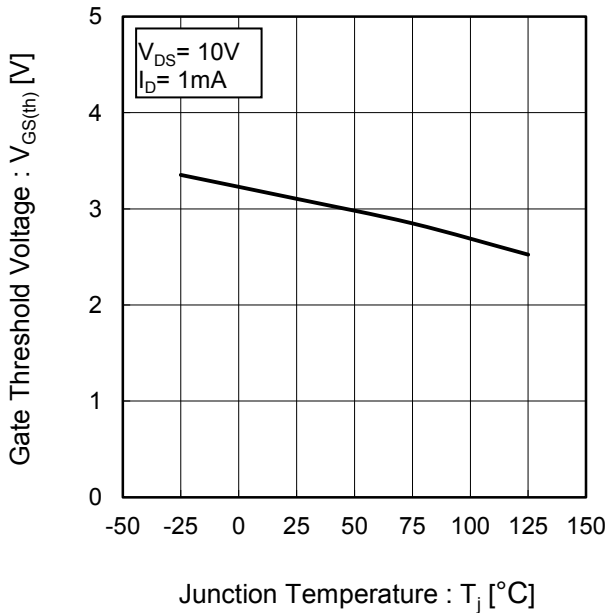
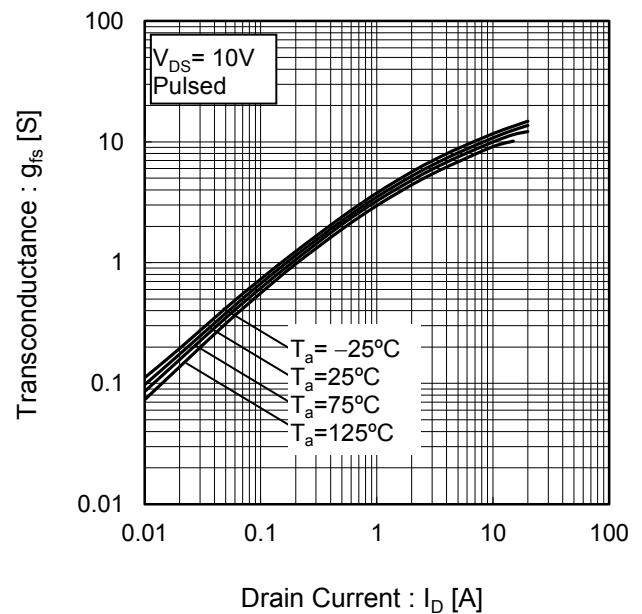


Fig.12 Transconductance vs. Drain Current

Fig.13 Static Drain - Source On - State Resistance vs. Gate Source Voltage

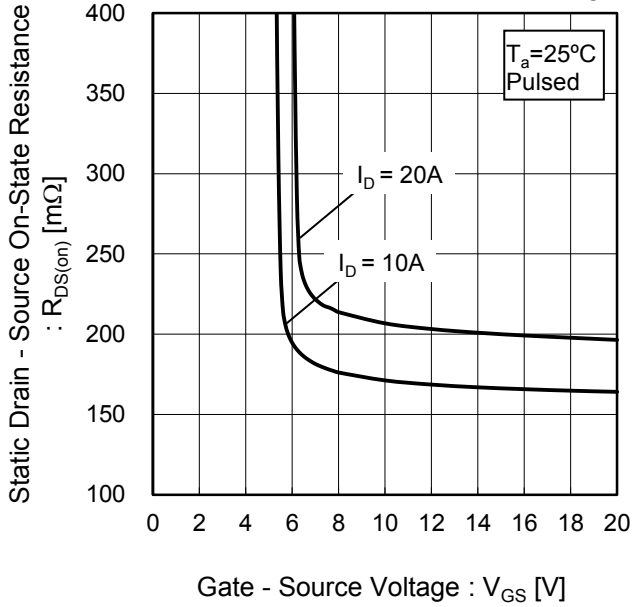


Fig.14 Static Drain - Source On - State Resistance vs. Junction Temperature

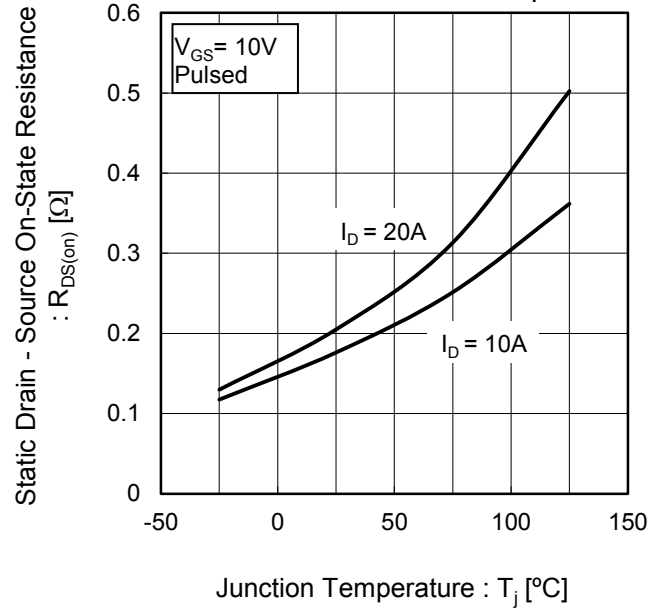
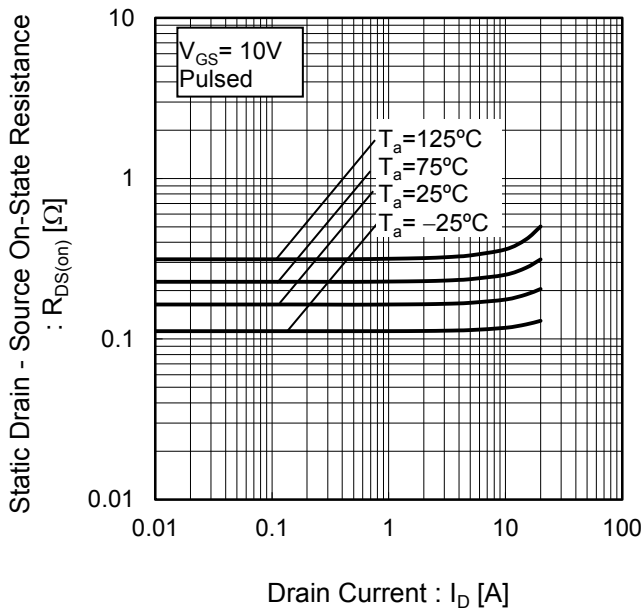


Fig.15 Static Drain - Source On - State Resistance vs. Drain Current

Fig.16 Typical Capacitance vs. Drain - Source Voltage

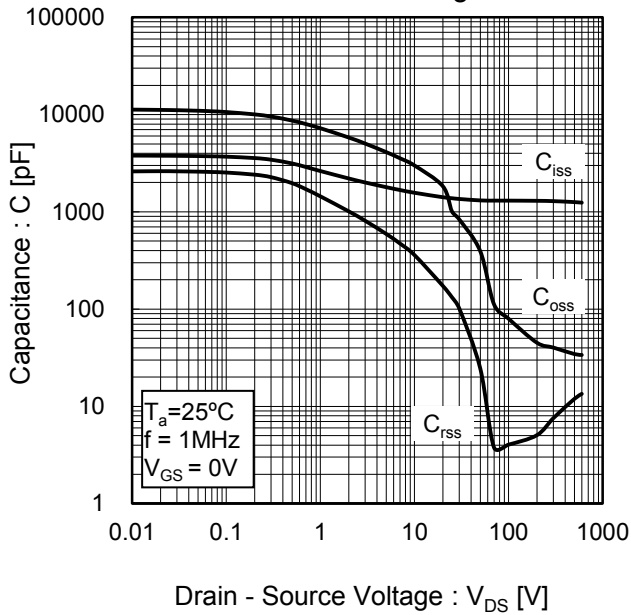


Fig.17 Coss Stored Energy

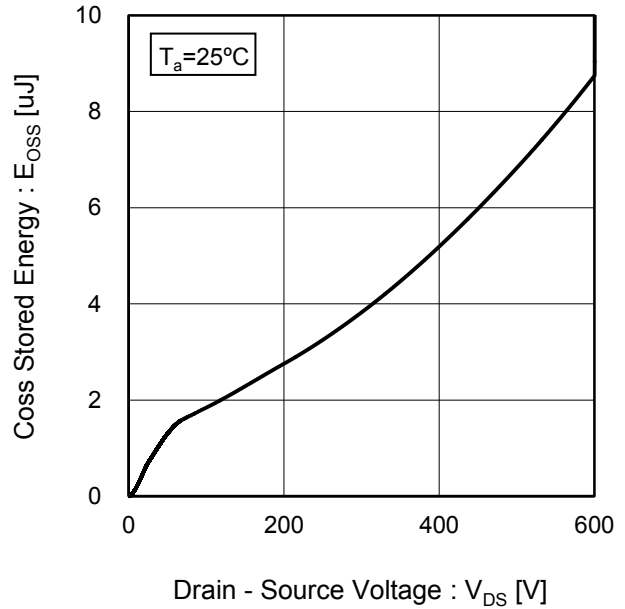


Fig.18 Switching Characteristics

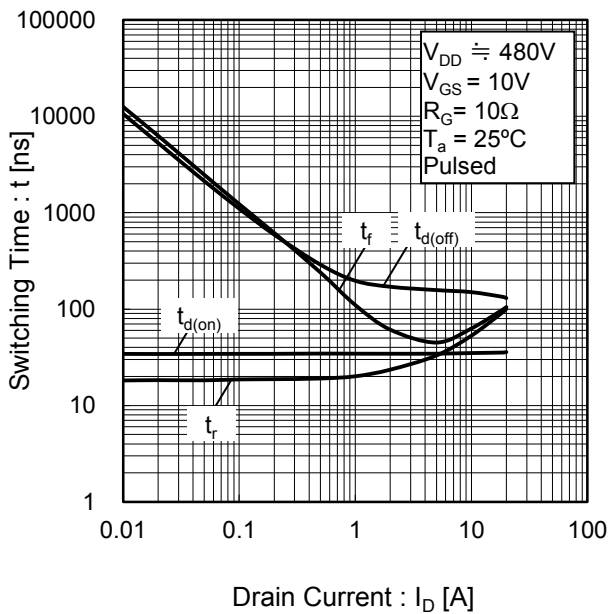
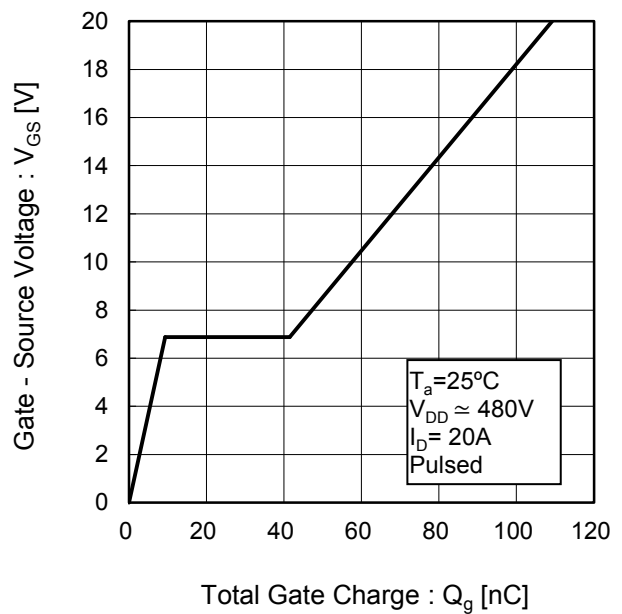


Fig.19 Dynamic Input Characteristics

Fig.20 Inverse Diode Forward Current vs. Source - Drain Voltage

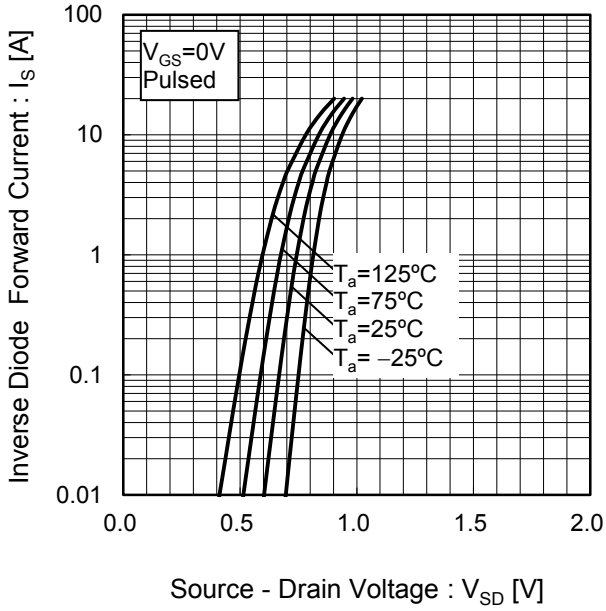
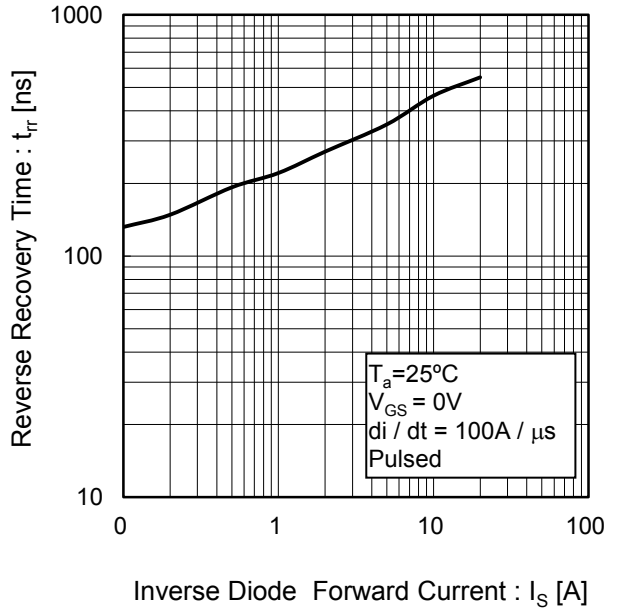


Fig.21 Reverse Recovery Time vs. Inverse Diode Forward Current

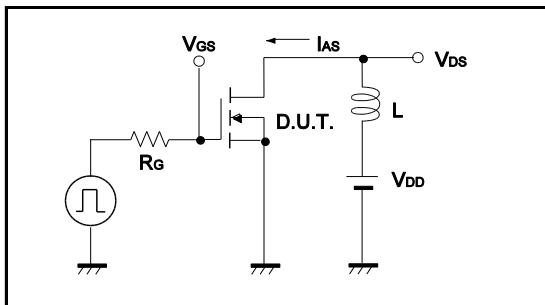


Fig.3-2 Avalanche Waveform

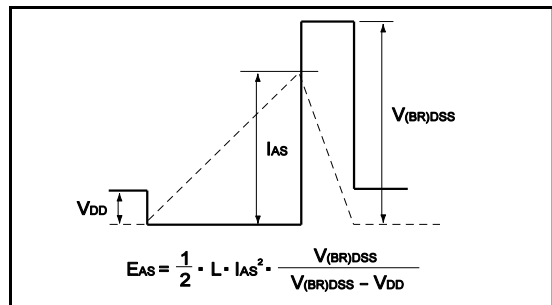


Fig.4-1 dv/dt Measurement Circuit

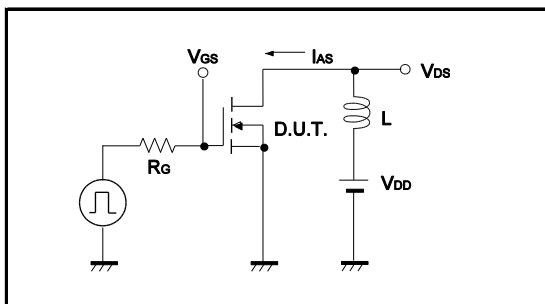


Fig.4-2 dv/dt Waveform

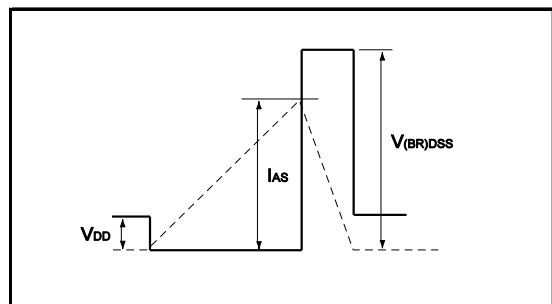


Fig.5-1 di/dt Measurement Circuit

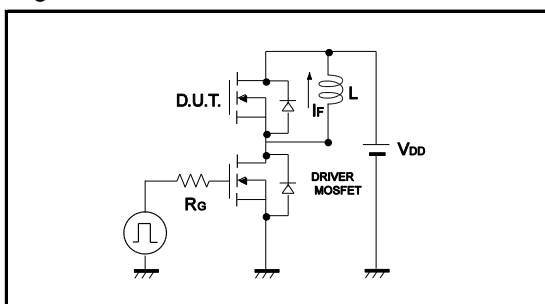
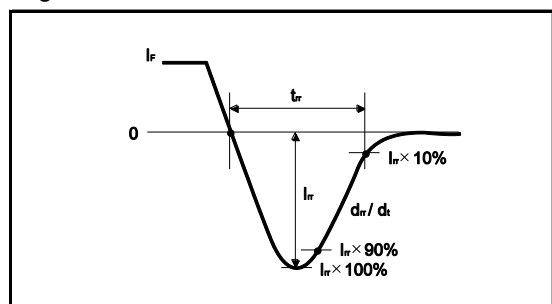
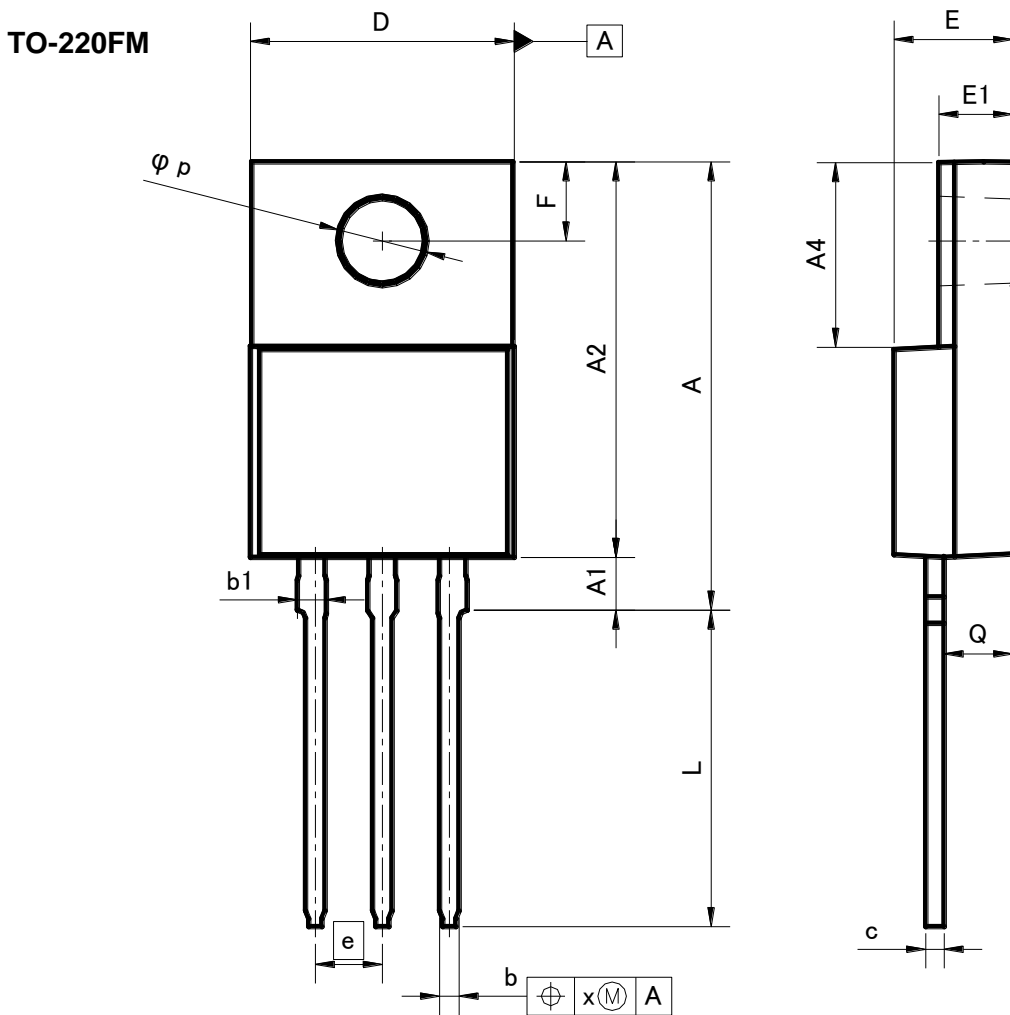


Fig.5-2 di/dt Waveform
